Goal for 2030

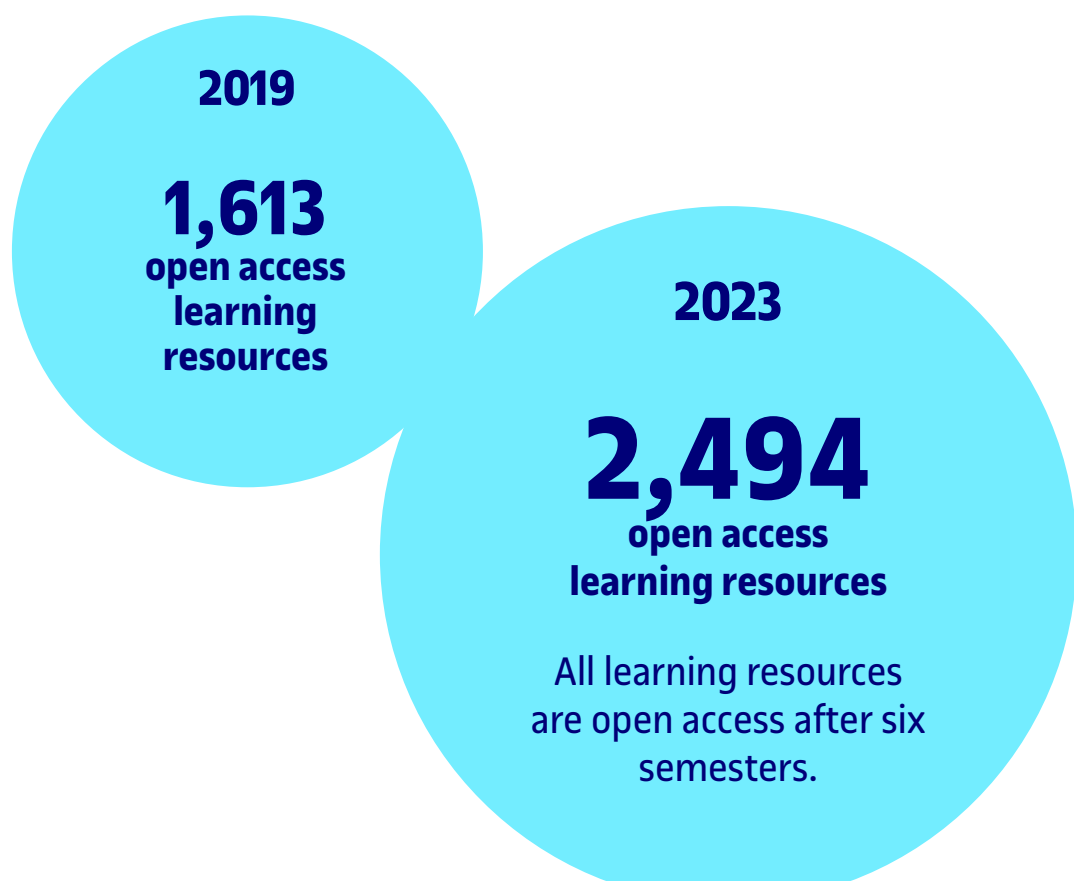
